How to update College Admission Status on Naviance

To keep updated with the most accurate information, all seniors will have access to update college admission status on Naviance. To do this you must:

1. Navigate to <https://student.naviance.com/knchs>
 - a. For many of you this login information was on your chromebooks. Reset your passwords if you need to.
2. Click **Colleges I'm Applying To** (see photo to the right →)
3. Click **Edit** (see screenshot below) and change **Result** based on the new information you received. Be sure to mark if you were waitlisted or deferred (see screenshot below)
4. Click **Save Application**.
5. If you have completed a Matriculation Meeting with a counselor, change the **College that I'm attending** and click **Update** (see screenshot below)

<p>Students who have officially made a decision with a KTC Counselor will then schedule a virtual meeting with a KTC Persistence Counselor (Ms. Dentor or Mrs. Fakunle). Frequently Asked Questions
<p>How do I know if I have been waitlisted?</p>

- It will say waitlisted.
- Being on a waitlist typically means that you are placed within a “holding pattern” of sorts. The admissions committee may or may not admit students from the waitlist. Email the admission office to find out if the college will be admitting students from the waitlist this year.

How do I know if I have been deferred?

- If the school would like to see more grades from senior year or new test scores.
- Being deferred can mean a wide variety of things. In most cases, the college has not completed its review of your file and is “deferring” their decision to a later date.

I have already completed my decision meeting, what’s next?

- Follow the Matriculation Guidelines above.

I have a question not related to the Learning Packet.

- Contact your assigned KTC Counselor.

What if I’m not going to college?

- Contact your assigned KTC Counselor.
