## 1 Possession of Firearms on School Property

- 2 KIPP Nashville is a gun-free school zone. In order to ensure the safety of our students,
- 3 staff, and community, possession of a firearm on school property is prohibited for
- 4 employees, students, families, and guests. It is a violation of KIPP Nashville policy and
- 5 state law for any person to carry a firearm or dangerous weapon on school premises,
- 6 school-provided transportation, or areas of other facilities being used exclusively for
- 7 school activities.

## 8 Exceptions

- 9 The following persons may carry firearms into school buildings, as necessary:
- 10 (1) Persons engaged in military, law enforcement, or school security activities; and
- 11 (2) Any federal, state or local law enforcement officer.
- 12 KIPP Nashville may suspend or expel a student for up to one year if the student has
- 13 possession of a firearm on school premises, school-provided transportation, or areas of
- 14 facilities while being used exclusively for school activities.
- 15 School officials shall notify the student's parents or guardians and the appropriate law
- 16 enforcement agency of known or suspected violations of this policy. Students who violate
- 17 this policy shall be subject to discipline, including a one-year expulsion for a violation
- 18 involving a firearm. However, the Director of Schools may modify the one-year expulsion
- 19 on a case-by-case basis.
