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- 1 KIPP Nashville is dedicated to the success of its students and will provide an alternative
- 2 learning opportunity in a virtual setting by following the State's guidelines and
- 3 recommendations. Virtual learning is temporary and shall not replace a student's regular
- 4 instructional program.

5 **Eligibility**

- 6 KIPP Nashville students are eligible to utilize a virtual instruction program if participating in
- 7 one of the following educational opportunities:
- 8 Academic remediation, enrichment, or providing students access to a wider range of
- 9 courses.
- 10 Continuity of educational service for students who are homebound.
- 11 Continuity of educational service for students who are quarantining due to a positive
- 12 COVID-19 test or result or possible exposure to COVID-19. Students may participate in
- 13 remote instruction during the period of quarantine only.
- 14 KIPP will also consider attendance, grades and technology when allowing students to
- 15 participate in virtual instruction.

16 **Attendance**

- 17 When students participate in virtual instruction due to one of the reasons above, KIPP
- 18 Nashville will track attendance by using two or more sufficient methods to ensure the
- 19 success of the student while he or she is not physically onsite.

- 20 Students participating in a phone call with a teacher, with parent/guardian support as
- 21 appropriate for the age of the student.
- 22 Students participating in a synchronous virtual instruction.
- 23 Students completing work in a learning management system.
- 24 Students submitting work via hard-copy or virtual formats.
